

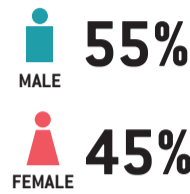

Here are some of the most interesting findings on local student and graduate job-hunting preferences from this year's Singapore's 100 survey!

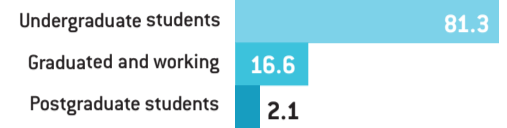

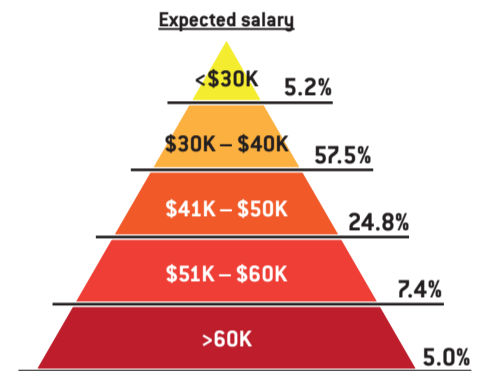

### EMPLOYMENT STATUS (%)

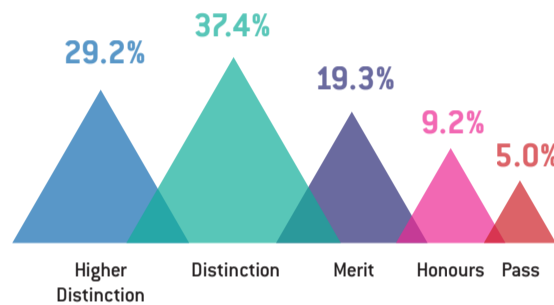


### HOW MUCH DO YOU EXPECT TO EARN PER YEAR IN YOUR FIRST PROFESSIONAL POSITION?

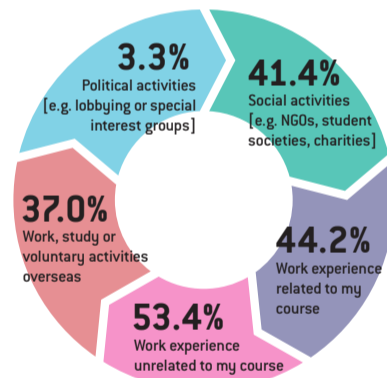


On average, students expect to earn **S\$42k** per year in their first job.

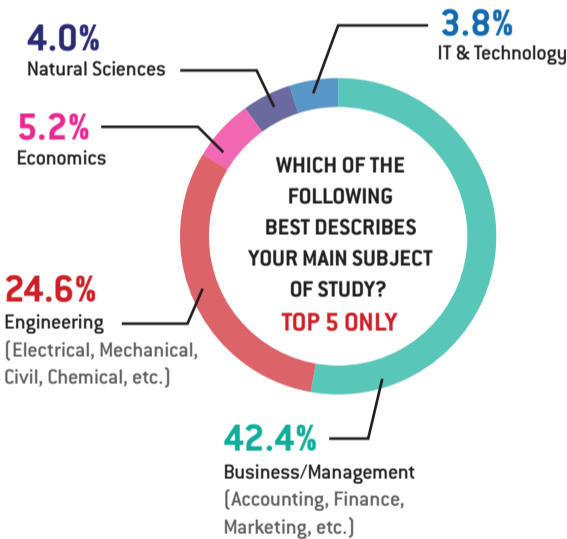
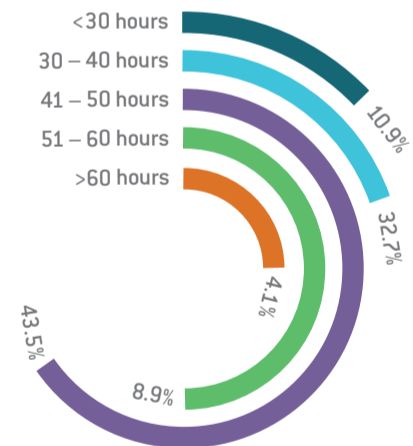

### WHAT EXPERIENCES OF AT LEAST 3 MONTHS' LENGTH DO YOU HAVE?

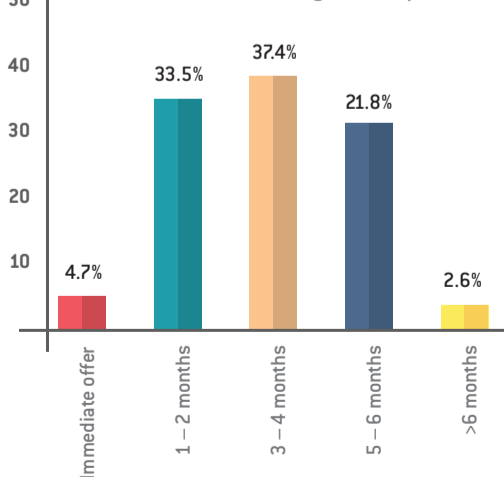


### HOW MANY HOURS DO YOU EXPECT TO WORK IN YOUR FIRST PROFESSIONAL POSITION EACH WEEK?

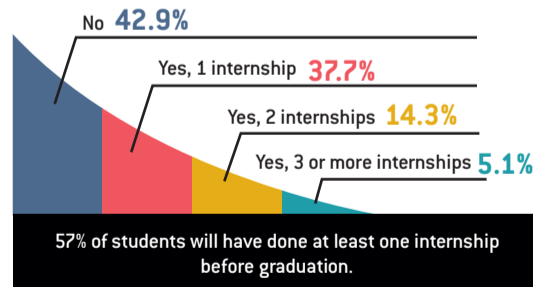


### HOW MANY MONTHS WILL YOU NEED TO FIND YOUR FIRST GRADUATE JOB?

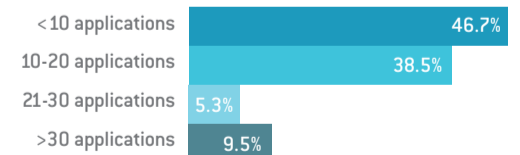
On average, students expect to be job hunting for 3 months before finding their first job.
